IN RE: MISCELLANEOUS ORDER COVID-19 EMERGENCY [EFFECTIVE June 3, 2021] **ENTRY**

WHEREAS, effective June 2, 2021 Stephanie McCloud, Director of the Ohio Department of Health rescinded health orders regarding the COVID-19 pandemic including the order requiring the use of facial coverings in public places.

NOW THEREFORE, effective June 3, 2021 the following rules and restrictions shall be followed subject to further order of the court:

- 1. The court order effective June 1, 2020 regarding COVID-19 shall no longer be in effect.
- 2. Except as otherwise set forth in the Order persons entering the court facility are not required to wear a mask.
- 3. Persons entering the court facility who have either not been vaccinated or feel uncomfortable not wearing a mask are encouraged to wear a mask.
- 4. Persons shall not enter the court facility if they are ill and/or have a temperature in excess of 100 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 5. The court reserves the right to require masks on a case by case basis.
- 6. All Plexiglas and other modifications to the court facility installed as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic shall remain in place until further notice.
- 7. Persons entering the court facility shall strive to maintain social distancing whenever possible.
- 8. The court will continue remote hearings as determined by the court to be appropriate.
