## Legislative News: Two-Week Review

- Keep an eye on our website for <a href="Enactment Summaries">Enactment Summaries</a> providing effective dates and explaining the various bills that were passed in December: <a href="SB 16">SB 16</a> (Increase in penalty for assault and amended to include changes to importuning crimes, to police riot powers, and to shackling of pregnant detainees); <a href="SB 288">SB 288</a> (the criminal justice omnibus that was heavily amended to include distracted driving restrictions, and clarification of charges allowable when a juvenile is bound over); <a href="HB 343">HB 343</a> (Marsy's Law, or the victims' rights bill); <a href="SB 202">SB 202</a> (a guardianship bill that was amended to include some portions of <a href="SB 199">SB 199</a>; and others.
- The 2022-2023 Biennial Report of the Ohio Judicial Conference is available on our website.
- On 1.3.23, the Supreme Court released <u>proposed Rule changes</u> for a second public comment period on the following proposed amendments to the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure (1, 1.1, 4.1, 4.6, 10, 26, 30, 33, 36, 37, 39, 43, 45, 53, 57, 65.1, 73, 75, and Civil Form 20), the Ohio Rules of Criminal Procedure (1, 2, 10, 12, 15, 33.1, 40, and 43), the Ohio Rules of Evidence (101, 601, 607, 609, and 616), and the Ohio Rules of Juvenile Procedure (1, 2, 8, 18, 27, 34, 35, and 41). Comments are due by 2.17.23.
- <u>SB 25</u> (Sen. Hackett) **Real Property Foreclosure**, introduced 1.23.23. The bill changes some procedures of real property foreclosures including the process of choosing whether to use a private selling officer: in every action demanding the judicial of real estate in which the debtor has failed to plead or otherwise defend as provided by the Rules of Civil Procedure, the judgment creditor may decide that the real estate be sold at a public auction by a private selling officer.
- <u>SB 26</u> (Sen. Manning) **Marijuana OVI**, introduced 1.23.23. The bill eliminates per se impairment for marijuana use, requires additional evidence of actual impairment, and allows for evidence that there was no impairment.
- Save the Date: <u>Summit on Children 2023</u> is scheduled for 3.16.23 3.17.23 at the OSU Ohio Union. The Summit on Children is an interdisciplinary team-based training hosted by the Supreme Court of Ohio Children and Families Section where juvenile court judges will come together with administrators of public children services agencies, child welfare attorneys, behavioral health providers, educators, and other community stakeholders. <u>Register</u> online through OhioCourtEDU.
