Due to the existing state and national emergency and concerns regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health Crisis, the Geauga County Court of Common Pleas is taking the following actions regarding the wearing of masks and items being brought into the courthouse:

1. The Court expects all persons entering the courthouse to wear a mask. If a person does not have a mask, one will be provided. Court staff is required to wear a mask when interacting with the public and encouraged to wear a mask when interacting in a group with other staff members.
2. Persons entering the courthouse are permitted to bring only the items necessary to conduct their business within the courthouse. Parties will be asked to return any unnecessary items to their vehicles.
