Legislative News: Two Week Review

- <u>SB 270</u> (Sen. Antonio) **Jail Procedures**, introduced 2.4.20. The bill requires the division of parole and community services to inspect the jails in Ohio for compliance with the minimum standards for jails and to investigate. This bill is identical to HB 502 (Rep. Crossman), introduced 2.11.20.
- <u>SB 271</u> (Sen. Antonio) **Inmates at Risk of Withdrawal**, introduced 2.4.20. The bill requires ODRC to establish procedures for an inmate who is found to be at risk of withdrawal from benzodiazepines, alcohol, and other addictive drugs. The bill applies to any facility that incarcerates a person for 120 days or longer. The procedures include training requirements and medical, dental and mental health screening requirements. If a decision is made to stop benzodiazepine use, it must be tapered off and an inmate must be seen by a psychologist within 48 hours.
- SB 276 (Sens. Manning, Roegner) LLCs, introduced 2.12.20. The bill is the Ohio Revised LLC Act.
- <u>SB 278</u> (Sens. Eklund, Lehner) **Parole Procedures**, introduced 2.12.20. The bill modifies parole procedures regarding prisoner access to information, presence of counsel, and appeals of decisions.
- <u>SB 279</u> (Sen. Maharath) **Distracted Driving**, introduced 2.12.20. The bill prohibits cell phone use while driving.
- <u>HB 500</u> (Reps. Kick, McClain) **Visitation Rights**, introduced 2.10.20. The bill creates a procedure by which relatives of an incompetent person or a ward can petition the probate court if those relatives are being denied visitation with the incompetent person or ward. The bill authorizes the court to assess costs on any party to the proceeding and to impose reasonable attorney's fees against a petitioner who brings a petition in bad faith or a party that unjustifiably denies visitation.
- <u>HB 506</u> (Rep. G. Manning) **Child Placement**, introduced 2.13.20. The bill prohibits removing an abused, neglected, or dependent child from foster care and placing the child with a relative if the child has been in foster care for 6 months or more or the child has never met the relative, unless the court determines the placement is in the best interests of the child.
- The Supreme Court's **Dispute Resolution** Section is convening its annual <u>Conference</u> on 3.10.20. Registration is available online until 3.6.20.
- The Ohio Public Defender Commission is seeking public comment on <u>guidelines for appointed</u> <u>counsel hourly rates and maximum fees</u>.
