GENERAL ORDER 21-04

The Trumbull County Court of Common Pleas Domestic Relations and Juvenile Division hereby amends the current protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19 til further order:

1. **All fully vaccinated persons, including employees, can resume activities without wearing a mask.** (Fully vaccinated refers to a person who is ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2 dose series, or ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine, per the CDC Public Health Recommendations for Vaccinated Persons);
2. All individuals that are not fully vaccinated in the State of Ohio shall wear facial coverings at all times upon entrance to or while in the Courthouse, unless they are stationary in their own personal workspace;
3. All persons shall continue to maintain six (6) feet of separation at all times, if possible;
4. The Court encourages all persons to continue good hygiene habits such as hand washing and the use of sanitization products while in the Courthouse; and
5. Any person – counsel, witness or party – who is exhibiting symptoms or who has knowledge of a recent COVID-19 exposure requiring monitoring or quarantining shall notify the Court immediately and shall NOT attempt to enter the building.

This Order shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
