For the purposes of interpreting this Court's Parenting and Companionship Guidelines (Standard Guidelines), the provisions set forth therein in Section 8.b Spring Break, the non-residential parent to have companionship/parenting time shall be construed as being only for the period of time originally set forth in the 2019-2020 academic calendar by the subject minor child(ren)'s school district of residence. The Governor's characterization of the current school closing does NOT modify the Court's Standard Guidelines.

All until further Order of the Court. IT IS SO ORDERED.
