H.B. 388 Budish	Road Naming	To designate a portion of United States Route 20 and certain streets in Painesville as the 'James A. Garfield State Historic Corridor.'	No impact	
H.B. 389 Phillips	Road Naming	To designate the portion of United States Route 33 known as the Nelsonville Bypass in Hocking county and Athens County the 'Governor Ted Strickland Highway.'	No impact	
H.B. 390 Brenner	Free Clinic Donations	To authorize nonrefundable tax credits for donations to free clinics.	No impact	
H.B. 391 Ramos	Beer Sales	To allow beer manufacturers to manufacture beer containing not more than 21% of alcohol by volume beginning on the effective date of this act, and, beginning one year after the effective date of this act, to allow the sale and distribution of beer containing not more than 21% of alcohol content of beer from 12% to 21% and to generally prohibit the inclusion of caffeine of other stimulants in beer containing more than 12% of alcohol by volume. H.B. 392 Stinziano	Alcohol Consumption	To provide persons under 21 years of age with a qualified immunity from prosecution for offenses involving underage alcohol possession or consumption if law enforcement personnel become aware of the offense solely because the person sought or obtained medical assistance, solely because another individual sought or obtained medical assistance for the person, or because the person requested law enforcement assistance to report a criminal offense, prevent a possible criminal offense, or request the investigation of a criminal offense. H.B. 393 Baker	Career Guide	To require public high schools to publish annually a career decision guide in its newsletter or on its web site.	No impact	
H.B. 394 Smith, Antonio	Immunizations	Regarding the authority of pharmacists and pharmacy interns to administer immunizations.	No impact	
H.B. 395 Ramos	Nutrition Programs	To require the Director of Job and Family Services to request a federal waiver of time limits for certain Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program recipients.	No impact	
H.B. 396 Becker	Tax Filings	To allow married couples to elect to file either separate state tax returns or a joint state return, irrespective of their federal filing status, and to declare an emergency.	No impact	
H.B. 397 Hill	Accident Scene	To increase the penalty for violations of failure to stop after an accident and failure to stop after a nonpublic road accident that result in the death of a person or serious physical harm to a person.	Potential impact. Send to Traffic L&P.

S.B. 259 Skindell	Tax Returns	To require that same-sex married couples who file a joint federal income tax return must file a joint state tax return.	No impact	
S.B. 260 Patton	Vehicle Sales	To prohibit the Registrar of Motor Vehicles from issuing a motor vehicle dealer's license or motor vehicle leasing dealer's license to a motor vehicle manufacturer for the retail sale or lease of new or used motor vehicles.	No impact	
S.B. 261 Bacon, Manning	Domestic Violence	To provide that a person who recklessly violates a protection order issued upon a petition alleging that the person committed an act of domestic violence, menacing by stalking, or a sexually oriented offense, is guilty of the offense of violating a protection order if the person has actual notice of the protection order, notwithstanding that the person has not been served with a copy of the protection order, to increase the penalty for violating a protection order or consent agreement issued or entered into in order to protect a family or household member from domestic violence, and to require law enforcement agencies to enter certain protection orders into the National Crime Information Center Protection Order File.
