H.B. 107 Baker	Highschool Internships	To authorize a tax credit for businesses that employ high school students in career exploration internships.	No impact	
H.B. 108 Baker, Schuring	Rape Crisis Centers	To add a representative of eligible rape crisis programs as a member of the State Victims Assistance Advisory Council, to require each person who registers as a sex offender to pay a one-hundred-dollar fee, to require the deposit of the fee into the Rape Crisis Program Trust Fund administered by the Attorney General, and to fund rape crisis centers out of the Fund. S.B. 085 Jordan, Beagle	Coin Sales	To exempt from sales and use taxes the sale or use of investment metal bullion and coins.	No impact	
S.B. 086 Jordan	County Investments	To require the Treasurer of State and each county investing authority to invest at least 5% of the state's total average investment portfolio of interim funds and in each county's total average investment portfolio of inactive moneys, respectively, in precious metals by June 30th of each year. S.B. 087 Skindell	Lake Erie Drilling	To ban the taking or removal of oil or natural gas from and under the bed of Lake Erie.	No impact	
S.B. 088 Skindell	Health Exchange	To establish the Ohio Health Benefit Exchange Agency and to establish the Ohio Health Benefit Exchange Program consisting of an exchange for individual coverage and a Small Business Health Options Program.	No impact	
S.B. 089 Skindell	Income Tax Credit	To grant a state earned income tax credit equal to a percentage of the federal earned income tax credit.	No impact
