

INFORMATION REGARDING CONTINUING HEARINGS
IN JUDGE BRANSTOOL'S COURT

The Licking County Common Pleas Court continues to closely monitor state and local responses to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak and will be following guidance provided by state and local public health agencies and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

While the Court remains open to the public and will continue to provide all essential services, in order to protect the public health, Judge Branstool has agreed to continue, to a future date, all civil and criminal matters scheduled for a jury trial, pretrial conference, evidentiary, or dispositional hearing during the period between Tuesday, March 17, 2020 through Friday, April 3, 2020. Orders rescheduling these events will be issued in each case. Case by case exceptions to continuances may apply. Other matters commonly handled by phone conference such as status conferences and scheduling conferences will remain as scheduled.
